## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Prospective applicants are required to meet the following eligibility requirements:

- U.S. Citizenship
- Currently enrolled in school in at least one of the following ways:
  - High school seniors attending school in the U.S. scheduled to graduate in the spring of 2021
  - College student attending school in the U.S. and in good academic standing
- Academic Standing: Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (B average) or higher – Official documentation required
- Applicants must provide letter of college acceptance
- Applicants must have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular activity, faith based, or other activities during the previous 3 years.

**Deadline: May 15, 2021**

5. Photo
6. Official *High* School Transcript
7. College Acceptance Letter
8. Documentation of leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular activity, faith based, or other activities during the previous 3 years.
