Prospective applicants are required to meet the following eligibility requirements and include this checklist with application: **Deadline: March 20, 2023**

U.S. Citizenship

Currently enrolled in school in at least one of the following ways:

High school seniors attending school in the U.S. scheduled to graduate in the spring of 2023

College student attending school in the U.S. and in good academic standing

Academic Standing: Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (B average) or higher – Official documentation required

Applicants must provide letter of college acceptance

Applicants must have documented and demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular activity, faith based, or other activities during the previous 3 years.

500-word minimum essay of one of the following prompts

Write an essay using one of the prompts below:

1. We take lessons from obstacles we encounter that can be fundamental to our later success. Reflect on a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?
2. Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief or idea you held dear. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?
3. Reflect on something that someone has done for you that has greatly impacted your life in a surprising way. How did the gesture motivate you to pursue even greater heights?
4. Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.
